Why both manual-handling options are listed

The generic organisational program provides broad workforce training for up to eight learners. Clinical Moving and Handling is a more specific practical program with a maximum of six learners.

Complex Healthcare training and competency services

Medecs can scope participant- or resident-specific Complex Healthcare training, practical instruction and competency verification. Programs may include bowel care, urinary care, diabetes, stoma care, enteral feeding, epilepsy and seizures, anaphylaxis, respiratory care, dysphagia and mealtime management.

Onsite — Tasmania	Training and practical assessment may be available, including competency verification where required.
Virtual — Australia-wide	Clinical Instructor-led training may be delivered through Microsoft Teams where the program is suitable for virtual delivery.
Typical capacity	Usually a maximum of six staff per clinical session, subject to the task, equipment and assessment requirements.
Pricing	Price on application. Scope may include clinical preparation, participant/resident plan review, training, competency verification, travel and reporting.
Indicative NDIS rate	\$143.04 per staff member per hour where the service is funded through an NDIS participant, subject to confirmation and quotation.

Part 3 — Enrolment, payment and booking conditions

Who pays?

Employer enrolment	If your employer enrolls you as a job requirement, the employer is responsible for the agreed fees.
Individual enrolment	If you enrol yourself and there is no employer payment arrangement, you are responsible for the course fee.

When and how payment is made

Individual course fees are generally payable during enrolment by debit or credit card. An enrolment may not be confirmed until required payment and enrolment information are received. Organisations with an approved trading account are invoiced under the agreed account, quotation or service agreement terms.

Private-program quotations

For onsite, private, customised or participant-specific services, the accepted quotation or service agreement confirms the price, minimum numbers, preparation, travel, venue, consumables, delivery arrangements and any non-recoverable costs. Those written terms apply together with mandatory consumer rights and Medecs public policies.

Cancellation, rescheduling and no-show summary

At a glance

Give at least two full business days' notice to cancel or reschedule without a cancellation fee. Contact Client Support as early as possible. Statutory consumer rights always apply.

Circumstance	Outcome or applicable fee
More than two full business days before commencement	No cancellation fee. Fees for the cancelled, undelivered service are refunded or, subject to availability, transferred.
Within two full business days, with a valid reason	A \$75 administration fee may apply or may be waived at a Medecs manager's discretion. The balance may be refunded or transferred.
No-show and rescheduled	Half of the course fee is payable. Any remaining amount may be transferred to the new booking.
No-show and not rescheduled	The full course fee is payable; no change-of-mind refund applies.
Required online activities not completed	Half of the course fee is payable before rescheduling.
Cancellation after commencement or substantive online access	No automatic change-of-mind refund. Medecs considers services supplied, the undelivered portion, circumstances and legal entitlements.

If Medecs changes or cancels delivery

If Medecs cancels a service or cannot deliver a material part, the customer may choose a suitable replacement or rescheduled service, an accepted credit, or a refund for the cancelled or undelivered portion. Medecs will notify affected customers as soon as practicable.

Your statutory rights

Consumer guarantees are protected

Medecs services come with consumer guarantees that cannot be excluded. Change-of-mind conditions do not restrict rights and remedies available under the Australian Consumer Law.

How to request a cancellation, transfer or refund

1. Contact Medecs	Email admin@medecslarning.com or telephone (03) 6272 1843. Written notice is preferred, but assistance is available.
2. Provide the booking details	Give the learner or customer name, course or service, scheduled date, booking or invoice reference, request, reason and preferred outcome. Do not email unnecessary health records.
3. Receive a written outcome	Medecs will confirm the decision, reasons, any fee, credit, transfer date or refund amount and available review options.
4. Approved refund	An approved refund is returned to the original payment method or authorised account within seven calendar days after approval, or within seven days after written notice where entitlement is automatic.

Fee protection and certification

Medecs protects prepaid learner fees in accordance with applicable RTO requirements. For nationally recognised training, certification is issued for successfully completed units after required assessment and verification processes are complete.
